Barnes Memorial Scholarship criteria that must be met to qualify:

- Will be a grade 1-12 student at BCS for upcoming school year
- Financial need (as identified through the Tuition Assistance application and qualification process)
- Is a current or incoming SAS student
- Essay describing the student's faith journey and desire for a BCS education
- Confirmation of student and family commitment to the educational therapy program

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps below must be complete for scholarship application to be considered.

Application Steps:

1. Parent or guardian must have submitted a fully complete application for Tuition Assistance by the April 15 deadline.
2. Student will write an original, personal essay which incorporates all 3 prompts:
 - What difference does knowing Jesus make in your life?
 - Why does a faith-based education matter to you?
 - How will participation in SAS help you achieve your personal and academic goals?Essay must be your personal story and not product of AI. Essay will be no longer than two pages. JH and HS students should follow the APA Style. If needed, 1st and 2nd grade students may verbally respond to the prompts and parent may write the responses.
3. Parent or guardian will write a several paragraph statement which articulates their commitment to the SAS program.
4. Student must submit this completed cover sheet, attaching their essay and the parent statement.
5. Student must give the attached Confirmation form to their SAS Therapist in advance so that the therapist is able to complete and return the form directly to the Finance Office by the deadline.
