Lloyd Adler Memorial Scholarship Application Cover Sheet

The Lloyd D. Adler Scholarship was established in 1992 by Mr. Adler's widow and son. Mr. Adler was the father of BCS alumni Bruce Adler, Class of 1961, and grandfather of BCS alumni Laurie Adler, Class of 1989. Mr. Adler was a high school biology teacher and college basketball coach before turning to a career in business.

As founder, president, and chairman of the board of the Wigwam Department Stores, he was able to supply BCS with a variety of donated goods in the early days of the school. He maintained an interest in supporting BCS students who needed tuition assistance and demonstrated Christian character and commitment, as exhibited in service to the school and the larger community.

Lloyd Adler Memorial Scholarship criteria:

- Will be a grade 1-12 student at BCS for upcoming school year
- Financial need (as identified through the Tuition Assistance application and qualification process)
- Essay describing the student's faith journey and desire for a BCS education, and demonstrating Christian character and commitment as exhibited in service to the school and the larger community
- An interest in biology or the sciences is also considered
- Recommendation reflecting Christian character and commitment as exhibited in service to the school and the larger community

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps below must be complete for scholarship application to be considered.

Application Steps:

- 1. Parent or guardian must have submitted a fully complete application for Tuition Assistance by the April 15 deadline.
- 2. Student will write an original, personal essay which incorporates these prompts:
 - What difference does knowing Jesus make in your life?
 - Why does a faith-based education matter to you?
 - What motivates you to serve at BCS (and in your community, if appliable)?
 - Tell us what drives your interest in Biology (or the sciences, in general).

Essay must be your personal story and not product of AI. Essay will be no longer than two pages. JH and HS students should follow the APA Style. If needed, 1st and 2nd grade students may verbally respond to the prompts and parent may write the responses.

- 3. Student must submit this completed cover sheet with their essay.
- 4. Student must request a recommendation from an unrelated adult that is associated with the student's service in advance. The recommender must have enough time to complete and return their recommendation directly to the Finance Office by the application deadline.
